POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Behavior Policy:

Happy Campers Day Camp, LLC reserves the right to remove a camper from camp for any unsafe or inappropriate behavior including: bullying, violence, sexual harassment, endangering the safety of any camper or staff member, any type of discrimination, destruction of property, theft, verbal abuse, and possession of any kind of weapon. No refunds for any camp fees paid will be issued in the event that a camper is asked to leave camp.

Medication Policy:

Campers are not permitted to carry their own medication at camp. All medications required by a camper at camp must be given to a camper's Camp Educators at sign-in on their first day of camp. Emergency rescue medication (such as inhalers, Benadryl, EpiPen, etc.) will be carried by camp staff and remain near your camper.

All prescription medication must be in the original prescription bottle with the camper's name on the label. Families are required to complete a medication authorization in their CampDoc Electronic Health Record for all campers requiring medication while at camp (including emergency rescue medication).

Please be sure that medication you are providing does not expire before a camper's last day at camp.

All remaining medication will be picked up by the camper's family at sign-out on their last day of camp.

Registration Policy:

There is a \$100 non-refundable registration fee. Any cancellation made up to 14 days prior to the start of a camp program will receive a full refund, minus the \$100 registration fee. Any cancellation made within 14 days of the start date of a camp program will not be eligible for a refund. All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is your drop-off & pick-up policy? Campers can be dropped off starting at 8:40am. Pick-up time is from 3:40-4:00pm.

What is your drop-off & pick-up policy? Camp will consist of a wide variety of activities based around our 4 themes: sports/fitness, science, arts and acts of kindness. This will include presenters, hands-on activities and choice time.

How many kids will be at camp?

We are planning on having 40-60 campers. We are hopeful that camp families will share the news and information with local family and friends. We will have 1 counselor per 8 kids registered.

Do you provide lunch for the kids?

No, typically you will have to provide your own lunch. However, there will be a couple special days when lunch will be provided. These dates will be shared with families ahead of time.

Do you accomodate kids with allergies? Yes, students with allergies will be accommodated. Please be sure to list all of your child's allergies when completing the camper registration so that we can best accommodate your child.
